



Information Bulletin From Council: CFN Additions to Reserve

As of October 22, 2020 Caldwell First Nation has 14 properties in the Addition to Reserve (ATR) process. These properties are in various stages, with different timelines for completion.

An Addition to Reserve

- ❖ enables Canada to fulfill legal obligations established by specific claim and treaty settlement agreements
- ❖ contributes directly to advancing reconciliation and improving the treaty relationship
- ❖ can improve community access to land and resources
- ❖ can increase community and economic development for First Nations

Steps/Processes to prepare and submit properties for ATR

- 1) Environmental assessments – Phase 1
 - 2) Environmental assessments – Phase 2 **Only if issues are identified in phase 1**
 - 3) Submission of EA's to Indigenous Services Canada for approval
 - 4) Reference Plans / Property Surveys
 - 5) Completion of application
 - 6) BCR Issuance
 - 7) Submission of EA's, Reference plan, Application, and BCR's
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ISC Stages for ATR

- 8) Assessment & Review – ISC Review of application/supporting documents, advises FN, Issuance of support to FN with successful applications
- 9) Application Completion – ISC and the FN work in tandem to create and execute a work plan for proposal completion
- 10) The Minister of Crown and Indigenous Relations approves proposals by Ministerial Order or recommends approval by the Governor in Council
