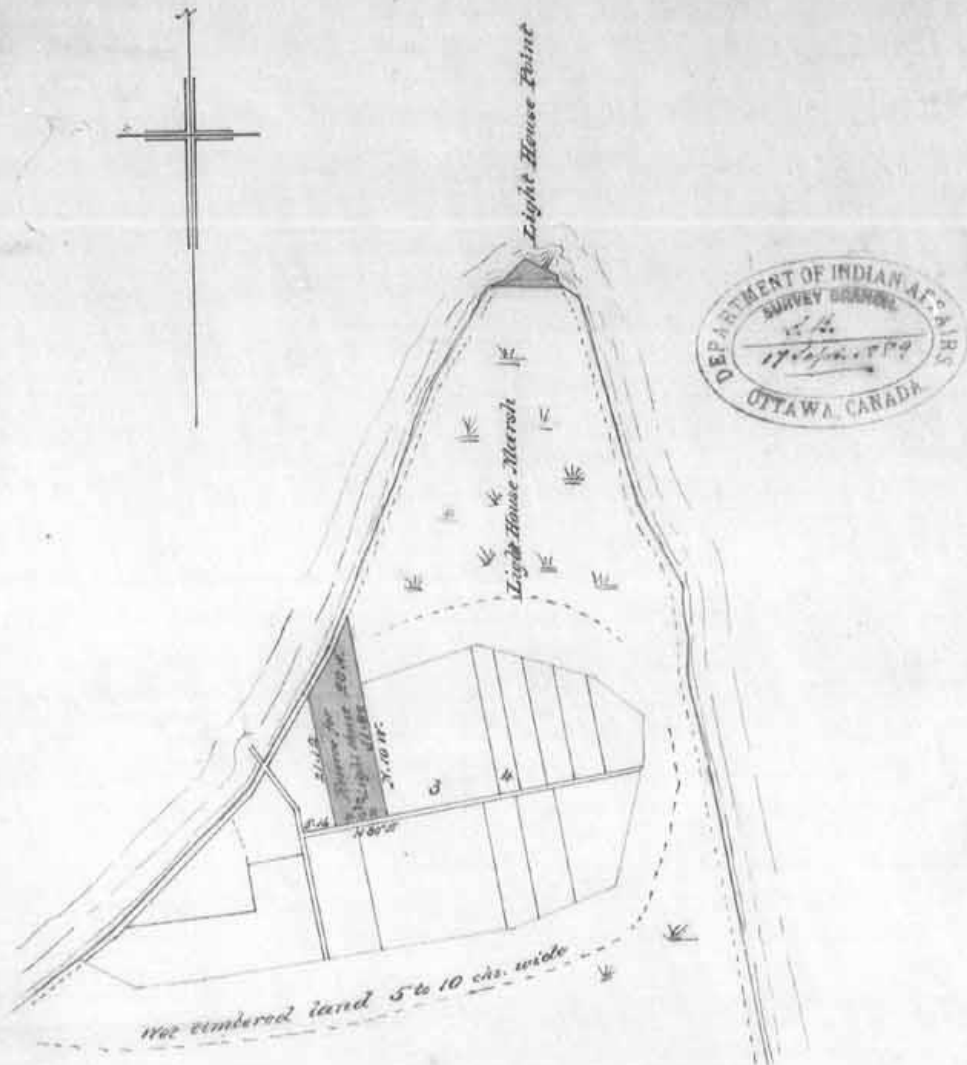

Lot No. 1 Light House Point
