The Ontario Indigenous Child & Youth Strategy Worker will be responsible to provide culturally based, holistic, and preventative supports for Bkejwanong Children and Youth.

Requirements:

- Minimum of Early Childhood Education Diploma or Social Services Worker Diploma preferred
- Current First Aid and CPR certificates or willingness to obtain
- Minimum of three (3) years' experience working with young children and families
- Two (2) years' experience working in a First Nations community
- Must possess a valid Ontario Driver's License, insurance, and dependable transportation
- Will be subject to a Criminal Reference Check and Vulnerable Sectors Check

Responsibilities:

- Asserting jurisdiction to ensure First Nations Children and Youth needs are being met and accomplished in a manner consistent with their rights as Indigenous people
- Utilize the Ontario Indigenous Child and Youth Strategy, Family Well-Being Programming, and other sources of support to enhance the lives of community members
- To promote and celebrate healthy families through family-based activities such as socials, feasts, family dances, and school activities and support for Youth activities
- To engage with other Walpole Island service providers in mapping available services and developing a plan for joint case management
- Attend meetings and network with other Independent First Nations in Ontario
